Introduction to the genre of Laments in Akkadian literature. Close reading of three

laments from the Old Babylonian period.

Course/Module aims:

Getting to know literary texts in Akkadian, familiarization with the Akkadian literary system, its poetic style, and typical language. Using advanced research tools (traditional and digital).

Students will get familiar with literary texts in Akkadian, especially with laments - a literary genre that is also known from the Bible. Their ability to deal with literary Akkadian text will certainly be better.
