The 2022 Regional Study Campus will be dedicated to the Negev Highlands. The campus combines the study of environmental and human aspects and traces the patterns of human activity that characterize the region throughout the periods in their environmental context.

Course/Module aims:

- Clarifying the patterns of ancient human activity in the Negev Highlands from a regional perspective.
- First-hand assimilation of environmental and cultural landscapes through prolonged stay and study in the field.
- Personal study of a phenomenon / site and their presentation in the field.
