participants will conduct short-term therapy with weekly supervision, and collect data on process ;and outcome using questionnaires.

Course/Module aims:

1. To gain experience in short-term psychodynamic psychotherapy 2. To understand basic processes in psychodynamic therapy- transference, countertransference, defenses, termination, and more. 3.To learn about research in psychodynamic therapy.

Learning outcomes - On successful completion of this module, students should be able to:

1. To understand the basic processes in short-term psychotherapy

2. To formulate simple research questions in this area and analyze them with the appropriate statistical tools.

Teaching arrangement and method of instruction: workshop to teach the CCRT MODEL weekly supervision of students' therapy tapes group discussion of research questions.
