Course/Module description:

The clinical practicum is a two year practicum in a variety of mental health sites. Students work in the same site for two years. In the second year of the program, they participate in individual supervision with the clinical faculty, according to specific treatment orientations

Course/Module aims:

Expanding their learning on therapy and therapy process in different orientations
