Participating students will get weekly tutoring at the department of psychology

The goal of the course is to provide the future neuropsychologists with a first-hand acquaintance with the major neurological diseases and with the mode of operation of neurology and neurosurgery departments, from which most of the patients requiring the neuropsychologist's services will come.
