Types of interviews. The three stages process of the interview. Identifying targets for treatment. Components of the Interpersonal communication : listening and observation, verbal and nonverbal communication, the influence of prejudices and stereotypes. Main skills related to the nutritional interview ; how to create the therapeutic alliance, how to build a therapeutic confidence, empathy and sensitivity and how to evoke the client's motivation to change nutritional behavior .
