# Course/Module description:

Geriatric Nursing: This course will focus on the unique aspects of nursing care of the elderly patient

Rehabilitation: This unit will present a model for addressing the complex needs of the patient in nursing rehabilitation. By reviewing the literature, knowing the theory of rehabilitation, disability, and epidemiological data, students will be exposed to basic principles that guide nurse activity in patient rehabilitation. This unit will also allow exposure to the professional boundaries of additional therapists in the multidisciplinary team in the rehabilitation process.

#### Course/Module aims:

- 1.To provide the students with theoretical and clinical knowledge in the topics listed below.
- 2.To provide the students with competencies of clinical thinking and of functioning in a multi-disciplinary geriatric team.
- 3.To focus on all the components of the nursing process, as it is practiced in providing nursing care to the geriatric patients and their families
- A. Acquisition of basic concepts and knowledge base in rehabilitation and disability-
- B. Familiarity with a rehabilitative model and key components of the rehabilitative approach on the basis of nurses' work

third. Exposure and understanding of the physiological, mental, emotional, family and social components of nursing care in the needs of the rehabilitative patient D. Familiarity with the roles and professional boundaries of additional caregivers in rehabilitative care and treatment sequence (between caregivers, between hospital and community)
