Course/Module description:

A Clinical course - the first exposure of the student to clinical treatment of patients. Each pair of students will work with one patient at a time (one student will serve as a dentist and the other as a dental assistance. The roles will reverse in the following week and vice versa).

The student will perform a full examination, radiographic diagnosis, determine a treatment plan and will perform the restorative part.

Course/Module aims:

- 1.The student will have the ability to treat a dental patient.
- 2.Data collection of the dental patient.
- 3.Preforming plastic restoration, in patients.
